

Notice to the Public:

Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Wesley Manor Retirement Community posts Title VI notices on our agency's website, in public areas of our agency, in our board room, and on our buses and/or paratransit vehicles.

Wesley Manor Retirement Community operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by Wesley Manor Retirement Community, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with Wesley Manor Retirement Community.

1. A Complaint Form may be obtained from the Wesley Manor Retirement Community website: www.WesMan.org, or in person from the Wesley Manor Retirement Community office at

2. In addition to the complaint process at Wesley Manor Retirement Community complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region 4, 230 Peachtree Street, NW, Suite 1400, Atlanta, GA 30303

3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
