Report on Weekly Testing

The State of Kentucky and CMS have made recommendations for long-term care facilities (Skilled Nursing Facilities, Assisted Living, and Personal Care), that all employees should be tested twice a week based on the states' and counties' positivity rate, until the rate remains below 10 percent for 14 days.

As of this date, after 2 weeks of testing, our employee population had one. Occasionally, an employee may have a family member who has tested positive. If that happens, those employees are not allowed back to work until they are tested negative.
