### Report on Weekly Testing

We now have our first resident (in the Health Care Center), test positive for COVID-19. Fortunately, this resident is asymptomatic at this time. We've had 2 staff test positive, as well. Both are at home and self-quarantining. Jefferson County is also an "orange" county based on the Commonwealth's measurement tools. All of these factors contribute to the determination that all residents and staff are to be tested weekly.

### Visiting in the Health Care Center, Assisted Living, and Personal Care

Visitation in all of our 3 divisions is postponed until we are clear of the virus. We will send notification to all of our families when we are able to re-start our visitation. (Window visits are still permitted). Group activities, communal dining, and non-critical medical appointments are also postponed at this time.
