Staff and residents in the Health Care Center, the Hoskinson House, and the received the second dose on Monday, January 11, 2021. The next clinic will be on February 1. We've received information from CVS Pharmacy that only booster doses will be offered on that date. I've logged a complaint with them regarding many of our residents who have not received their first doses because of they tested positive. We need them to be vaccinated. Also, I've asked for our Patio Home residents to be able to get their vaccines on February 1.
